MOTIVATIONAL STORY

Shri Devendra Jhajharia (Padma Bhushan)



Shri Devendra Ihajharia is an Indian Para-Javelin thrower and the first Indian Para-athlete to win two gold medals at Paralympics. Born on 10" June, 1991 in Jaipuria Khalsa (Churu district) of Rajasthan, He lost his left hand at the age of 8 years due to an unfortunate accident. This incident shattered him mentally and physically but, he decided to change the future course of his life. He took up sport as a challenge and decided to make the mark in Javelin. He participated in the national championship at Bangalore in 2001 and won the first gold medal in javelin. In 2002, he won the first international gold medal in Fespic games held in South Korea. He has won two Gold Medals in Paralympics and a Silver Medal in Tokyo 2020, making him the first ever para-athelete to bring two Gold and a silver for the country. Shri Devendra has been honoured with several National Awards like Special Commendation Award by the Hon'ble President of India, Arjuna Award.

Shri Harekala Hajabba (Padma Shri)



Shri Harekala Hajabba is an orange vendor in the city of Mangalore, Karnataka. He saved money from his vendor business to build a school in his village. One day a foreign tourist couple came to Shri Hajabba and asked the price of Oranges but he couldn't answer because he didn't study English not even Kannada Letters. At that time, he decided to educate the children of his village. Due to his hard Work and by the help of government officers, political leaders and family members, Shri Hajabba finally started Istandard school on 6th June 1999. The Deputy Commissioner granted 40 cents of land for Government school at New PadpuHill. With the help of donors, school building was inaugurated in August 2001. In 2004, there were four teachers and 125 students in the school. Through his untiring Efforts, he was able to start a higher secondary school in 2007. He has received various honours and awards. Karnataka Government awarded Kannada Rajyostava Award to him in 2013-14.


